#### **Job Summary:**

## **Key Responsibilities:**

- Check in all material for foundations, slabs, masonry, and framing.
- Verify all steel locations in footer, stem wall, slab, masonry walls and beam.
- Lay out footers and slabs as per site plan.
- Verify all elevations to confirm proper FFE using site plan and laser.
- Layout and confirm masonry openings for windows.
- Read truss drawing and Layout trusses.
- Bearing wall layouts and understating of various nailing patterns.
- Inspect trucks, machines, and trailers weekly to avoid any costly repairs of equipment. Arrange for repairs of equipment or machinery, as needed.
- Supervise, coordinate, or schedule the activities of the shell construction to include site work, footer, stem wall, slab, masonry walls and framing.
- Coordination with Purchasing to confirm upcoming schedules and review payments.
- Drive upcoming jobs and assess accessibility/readiness.
- Schedule all work to be completed, coordinate dates with employees as well as subcontractors a week ahead of time.
- Update schedules daily and move dates as needed based on proficiency and weather delays.
- Update Daily Logs daily with status of job and include multiple pictures.
- Read specifications, such as architectural drawings and site plans, to determine construction requirements or to plan procedures.
- Inspect work progress, equipment, or construction sites to verify safety or to ensure that specifications are met.
- Analyze worker or production problems and recommend solutions, such as improving production methods or implementing motivational plans.
- Upon completion of each phase of construction (Site work, concrete, masonry, framing) report if materials are short or left over so we can update take offs on future jobs.
