Duties:

Drywall Repair:

- Identify and address any imperfections or damage in drywall surfaces.
- Coordinate with vendors to come and make the drywall repair.
- Occasionally make small drywall repairs.

Stucco Repair:

- Assess and repair stucco surfaces, addressing cracks, chips, or other damages.
- Coordinate with Warranty Manager to get timeline for stucco repairs in accordance with warranty guidelines.
- Schedule vendors to come to residence to make repairs.
- Apply and blend stucco materials to match the original texture and appearance.

Quality Control:

- Conduct thorough inspections of completed work to ensure it meets quality standards on a 120 point inspection.
- Address any deficiencies or touch-ups with Superintendent or Warranty Manager to schedule accordingly.
- Accurately take photos and make notes on specific items that need to be replaced or repaired with proper documentation.

Communication:

- Maintain effective communication with team members, project managers, and homeowners.
- Report progress, challenges, and completed tasks on a regular basis.
- Effectively discuss any open punch items accurately to appropriate personnel.
- Ability to answer and return calls, text messages, and emails in a timely manner.
