## Routine Cleaning Tips

### Weekly Dusting:

- Use a feather duster, Swiffer duster, or dry microfiber cloth.
- Avoid paper towels and dishcloths, as they may cause scratches.

### Monthly Cleaning:

- Mix 2 tablespoons of mild dish soap with 2 cups of warm water.
- Dampen a clean microfiber cloth with the solution and wipe down cabinet exteriors.
- Immediately dry with a separate microfiber cloth.
- **Pro Tip:** Apply cleaner to the cloth, not directly to the cabinet surface



## What Not To Use

### Avoid the following products and tools:

- Abrasive or chemical cleaners (bleach, ammonia, citrus cleaners)
- Scouring pads, steel wool, or magic erasers
- Wax-based or polishing products
- Sponges, dishcloths, and paper towels

## Long-Term Maintenance

### Quarterly Deep Cleaning:

- Empty cabinets, vacuum out debris.
- Use the soap and water method for interior cleaning.
- For tough spots, use a paste of baking soda and warm water.

### Hardware Maintenance:

- Clean knobs and handles with the same mild soap solution.
- Periodically tighten screws to prevent loosening.



## Environmental Considerations

### Sunlight:

- Use window coverings to prevent fading and discoloration.

### Smoke:

- Ensure proper ventilation near cooking areas.

### Heat:

- Avoid using the oven's self-cleaning feature near cabinetry without removing adjacent doors/drawers.

### Humidity:

- Maintain indoor humidity between 30%-60%.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to moisture—immediately wipe any wet surfaces.
